## Ferry firm tries out cunning stand design

ROLL your bike into the new BumpStop stand and it clamps onto the front wheel holding the bike upright. It's designed for maintenance jobs, but is also being tried out by a ferry firm.

Alto Performance says the stand can also simplify the task of transporting your bike in a van, by keeping the bike more secure than it would be strapped down on the sidestand.

The stand can be used with

two wheelers ranging from scooters to sports bikes. They are constructed from steel and feature a power-coated finish. Colours available include red, black, and blue, and the stand is priced at £116.

A specially-adapted version is being trialled by Condor Ferries, which is looking for a means of supporting motorcycles during its regular sailings to the Channel Islands.

The ferry firm required the design of the stand to be modified to allow it to remove the stands quickly, to free up space if no motorcycles are onboard.

If adopted by other ferry firms, the stand could take the worry out of strapping down your bike before a crossing or trying to secure it with rope.
